

### PISTOL AUSTRALIA INC.

### CHARTER FOR THE NATIONAL COACHING COUNCIL

It is the purpose of this Charter to provide Pistol Australia Inc. (PA) with the rules governing the formation and management of a standing sub-committee within the structure of PA.

# 1. CHARTER

- 2. Name: The National Coaching Council (NCC).
- 3. **Objective**: To develop qualified coaches in the sport of target pistol shooting.
- 4. **Council**: The National Coaching Council shall be representative of all PA affiliates. These representatives shall be:
  - 4.1. State/Territory Coaching Directors or appointee;
  - 4.2. PA National Development Coach;
  - 4.3. National Coaching Council Director;
  - 4.4. Member of PA Management (ex officio).

# 5. National Coaching Council Director:

- 5.1. Shall chair the Council meetings and be responsible for implementing all Policy.
- 5.2. Shall be elected for a period of three (3) years.
- 5.3. The position of NCC Director shall be determined by election at the Annual General Meeting of PA.
- 6. Meetings: The Council shall meet at least twice a year.
- 7. Finance: To be provided by:
  - 7.1. PA
  - 7.2. Other sources.

### 1. REGULATIONS

- 2. Aim: To achieve the objectives set out in the NCC Charter by:
  - 2.1. Increasing the number of accredited active PA coaches at all levels;
  - 2.2. Developing and implementing a curriculum approved by PA NCC for the training and accreditation of coaches;
  - 2.3. Monitoring the activities and assessing the capabilities of all accredited coaches, particularly Competition Coaches and Advanced accredited coaches;
  - 2.4. Planning and developing changes to the approved curriculum to cater for changes in technology, shooting techniques and other related matters;
  - 2.5. Conducting seminars and other activities related to the coaching of target pistol shooting.

- 2.6. Providing a clear pathway for, and encouraging the advancement of PA coaches at all levels.
- 2.7. Informing PA coaches of new developments and understanding of coaching techniques and procedures, and implement these changes.
- 3. Management: The NCC Director shall be responsible for:
  - 3.1. The overall management of the NCC;
  - 3.2. Ensuring the training and accreditation standards for coaches required by the Shooting Australia are met;
  - 3.3. Maintaining an up-to-date Register of all NCC and Shooting Australia accredited pistol coaches;
  - 3.4. Ensuring the proper conduct of NCC sponsored activities;
  - 3.5. The development and conduct of examinations for coaching and coach accreditation;
  - 3.6. The development of a program to ensure all accredited coaches are kept aware of and conversant with new and changing coaching methods;
  - 3.7. The co-ordination and development of recommendations on grading levels, shooting standards and associated matters for submission to PA Management:
  - 3.8. The development of assessments/recommendations for notification of changes in accreditation;
  - 3.9. Submitting timely reports on NCC activities to PA Management, State Secretaries, NCC members and the 'Australian Pistol Shooters Bulletin';
  - 3.10. Submitting within 30 days of any NCC activity that involved expenditure in excess of \$100.00, a detailed report on the prescribed form, to PA Management;
  - 3.11. The development of a budget for the NCC for timely submission to PA Management:
  - 3.12. Report to PA Management on performance against budget as and when required;
  - 3.13. Any other such matters or things as are conducive to or incidental to the NCC objectives.
- 4. **Meetings**: The business of the NCC will be conducted at two meetings per year and such other meetings as required:
  - 4.1. At any meeting of the NCC, the Director shall be Chairman. In his absence, a Chairman may be elected from those present;
  - 4.2. Business at any NCC meeting may be decided by a simple majority vote, in the case of a tied vote the Chairman shall have an additional casting vote;
  - 4.3. All business at any NCC meeting shall be minuted and copies circulated within 21 days to the NCC, the PA Sport Administrator, and to PA Secretary/Management;
  - 4.4. No meeting of the NCC shall occur unless a simple majority the eight councillors are present.
- 5. **Miscellaneous**: Amendment to this Charter and Regulations will be by way of recommendation to PA Management Committee.
